



# Our topic this term in Explorers is Identity and Diversity



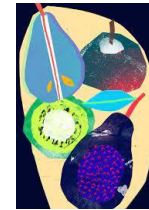
In English, we will be:

- Publishing a community cookbook.



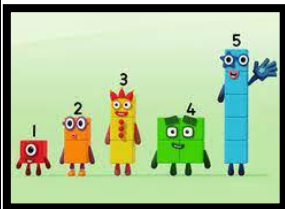
In Art, we will be:

In Maths, we will be:
