# **About Our School**



Delce Academy is proud to be a community school in the heart of Rochester in Kent.



We have been the lead Academy as part of the multiacademy Castle Trust since 2014, which means we are funded directly by the Government and are independent from Medway Council. Other schools within the Castle Trust are Greenway Academy and from September 2019 Bridge Specialist Academy.

At Delce Academy we have approximately 610 children in the school and our standard number of admissions each year is 130 pupils in Key stage 2 and 30 pupils in Early Years Foundation Stage and Key Stage 1. Since the opening of the one form reception class in 2016 some children now start school after their fourth birthday and stay with us until they reach the age of eleven. The additional key stage 2 children join the Academy at the start of Key stage 2 when they transition from a number of local infant schools at the age of seven and stay with us until the age of eleven.

The school is set in wonderful green, spacious grounds and located within walking distance of the Historic Rochester High Street. This provides a number of opportunities for the children to learn and explore outside of the classroom.

At all stages of the children's education there is a rich creative curriculum designed to ensure engagement, critical thinking and active learning for every child. Professional and committed staff within the Academy ensure that all pupils are supported to reach their full potential by enhancing their strengths and overcoming challenges. This was highlighted by Ofsted, who reported that:

'Pupils behave well, are respectful and tolerant of others. The school cares for its most vulnerable pupils, including those who attend specialist provision in 'The Bridge', very well.' (Ofsted 2017)

Information regarding progress and development is regularly communicated to parents and in addition to Pupil Learning Conferences teachers are happy to see parents whenever any concerns arise.



Our governors take an active part in the life and well-being of the school and undertake their duties through a range of committees as well as visiting the classes and attending school functions and celebrations. Periodically vacancies occur within the Local Advisory Committee and parents are warmly invited to apply and undertake a fulfilling role in supporting Delce Academy.










### **Winter Uniform**




