


Our topic this term in Year 5 is Sustainable Development with a specific focus on Environmental Leadership and Natural Disasters.



In English, we will be:

In Geography, we will be:

- Planning towards our curriculum outcome which is public service announcement on the effects of climate change.
- Identifying and planning appropriate action(s)and opportunities to make our own voices heard.
- Develop a willingness to take an informed stand on global issues.



In Maths, we will be:

- Adding decimals within 1 as well as adding decimals with the same number of decimal places.
- Multiplying by 10; 100 and 1000.
- Dividing by 10; 100 and 1000.
- We will be multiplying 4-digit numbers by 1-digit using formal written methods.



In Science, we will be:

- Describing the differences in the life cycles of a mammal, an amphibian, an insect and a bird.
- Describing the life process of reproduction in some plants and animals.



In RE, we will be:

- Exploring what the Buddhist Community Worldwide.
- Understanding which places are special to Buddhists.

In RSE, we will be:

- Identifying what makes a healthy friendship and how they make people feel included.
- Developing strategies to help someone feel included.
- Examining the impact of the need for peer approval in different situations, including online.

In Art, we will be:

Creating line art in the style of Sarah Young.

In Music, we will be:

Exploring musical styles and song writing for PSA

In French, we will be:

Learning about how to describe the weather and directions
