

Our global theme this term in Henson is Identity and Diversity with a specific focus on the impact of stereotyping and prejudice.




### In English, we will be:

### In Maths, we will be:

- Multiplying proper fractions by whole numbers using pictorial representations.
- Multiplying mixed numbers by integers.
- Finding fractions of amounts and exploring the relationship between decimals and fractions.




## In History, we will be:

- Making connections between the Ancient Greek and British Democratic system.
- Analyzing how laws and legislations were made in Ancient Greece.
- Developing a line of enquiry and collaborating to organise a manifesto to evoke change against stereotyping and prejudice.



## In Science, we will be:

- Recognising that circuits need to be complete to work.
- Categorising conductors and insulators
- Constructing circuits from circuit diagrams using pictorial representations and symbols
- Investigating the effect of adding different components or cells to a circuit.



#### In RE, we will be:

- Making connections between the Jewish and Christian religions.
- Evaluating the friendships and relationships Jesus made with his twelve disciples.

- Identifying jobs that we may like to do in the future about the role ambition can play in achieving a future career.
- Describing stereotyping in the workplace, its impact and how to challenge it.
