- Writing about how we can help save the bees.




In Art, we will be:

- Experiment with a range of materials to paint with, such as bubble wrap, scrunched up paper, cotton buds and sponge.

In Maths, we will be:

- Exploring the composition of numbers 9 and 10,
- Exploring addition and subtraction within 10,
- Investigating number bonds to 10 and using this knowledge to support one more and one less.





In Curriculum, we will be:

- Exploring sustainability by showing an appreciation of and care of living things such as bees in our environment.
- Creating our own bee garden to support the local bee populations
- Conducting a tour of our bee gardens for our school and the wider local community.
