In English, we will be:

- Exploring the core text "Boy in the Tower" to gain insight into Ade's character and how he overcame adversity.
- Writing a witness statement as an incidental write.
- Writing newspaper article recounting the key events that have occurred.



In History, we will be:

- Making connections between the Ancient Greek and British Democratic system.
- Analyzing how laws and legislations were made in Ancient Greece.
- Developing a line of enquiry and collaborating to organise a manifesto to evoke change against stereotyping and prejudice.





In Maths, we will be:

- Multiplying proper fractions by whole numbers using pictorial representations.
- Multiplying mixed numbers by integers.
- Finding fractions of amounts and exploring the relationship between decimals and fractions.



In Science, we will be:

- Identifying the planets that make up our solar system.
- Explaining the relationship between the Earth, Sun and Moon.
- Understanding how we get day and night.





In RE, we will be:

- Making connections between the Jewish and Christian religions.
- Evaluating the friendships and relationships Jesus made with his twelve disciples.

In RSE, we will be:

- Identifying jobs that we may like to do in the future about the role ambition can play in achieving a future career.
- Describing stereotyping in the workplace, its impact and how to challenge it.
