English alphabetic code

- 44 sounds
- Over 150+ graphemes

- One of the most complex alphabetic codes in the world.

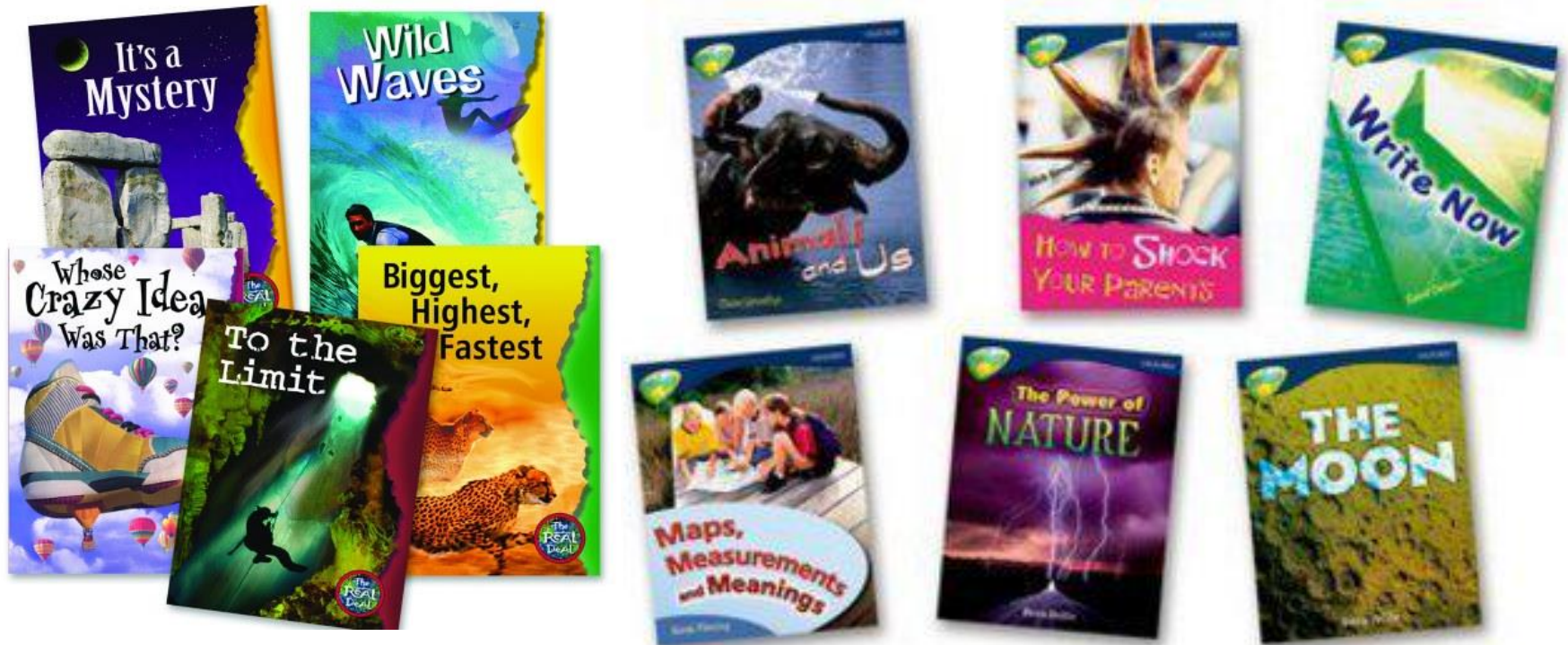
