Re: Full Re-opening of schools

I am writing on behalf of the Inspire Partnership to say how delighted we all are to be able to welcome all children and families back to school on March 8th 2021.

Following Monday's government announcement, staff and governors across the Partnership are putting in place measures to ensure schools are safe and ready to open fully.
